

Brown Paper Hanging Heart

Find some brown paper bags

Give each student a brown paper bag and have them cut out two hearts. One for the front of the ornament and one for the back. Then give each student a hand full of cotton balls to stuff their creation. Make sure to leave room to glue it together.



Grap some low-heat glue guns


Have each student glue the front and back heart together. Tip: If you put a dot of glue at the top of the heart and one at the base of the heart, keeping the heart together is much easier.





Add embellishments

Create a table full of fun embellishments for the kids to choose from. Lots of ribbon, flowers, buttons and sparkly gems make this project really exciting.





Use a hole punch to make to holes on each side of the heart. Grab some 12 inch wire from your local craft store and wrap it around a pencil to make it springy. Put the wire through the punched holes and secure. A great gift idea for parents!
